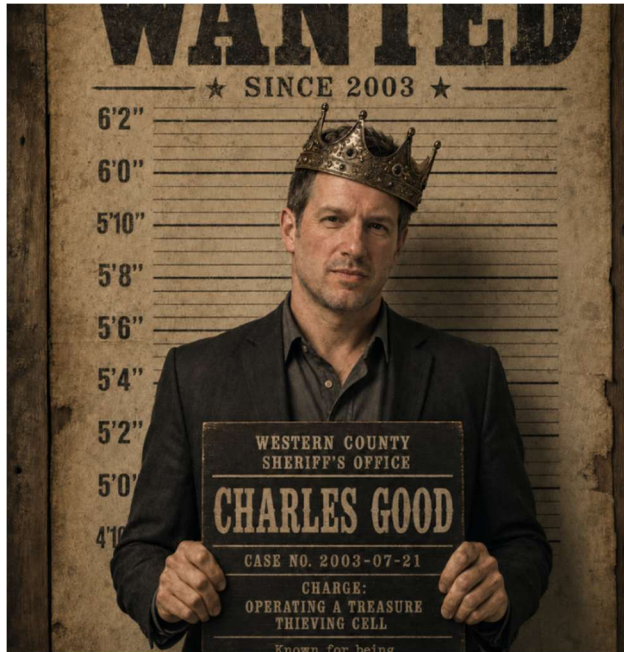

INTERVIEW NOTES:

On 09/01/26 at approximately 1930 hrs, members of the Police Department, Central Detective Division - Cyber & Gaming Unit, initiated surveillance on Charles Good in connection with The Treasure Hunt Amusement Park Heist and an ongoing investigation into a loosely organized group known to law enforcement as "The Rift Raiders," a collective of individuals allegedly coordinating proxy treasure hunts using League of Legends metaphors and gaming strategy as cover for criminal activity.

Investigators observed Good meeting with several known fugitives at Pixel Park Gaming Café. Subjects discussed "objective control," ward coverage, and "jungle pathing" in a manner consistent with tactical evasion and evading law enforcement. Good was seen drawing maps of parks and sewer access points, marking them with icons matching League of Legends jungle camps.

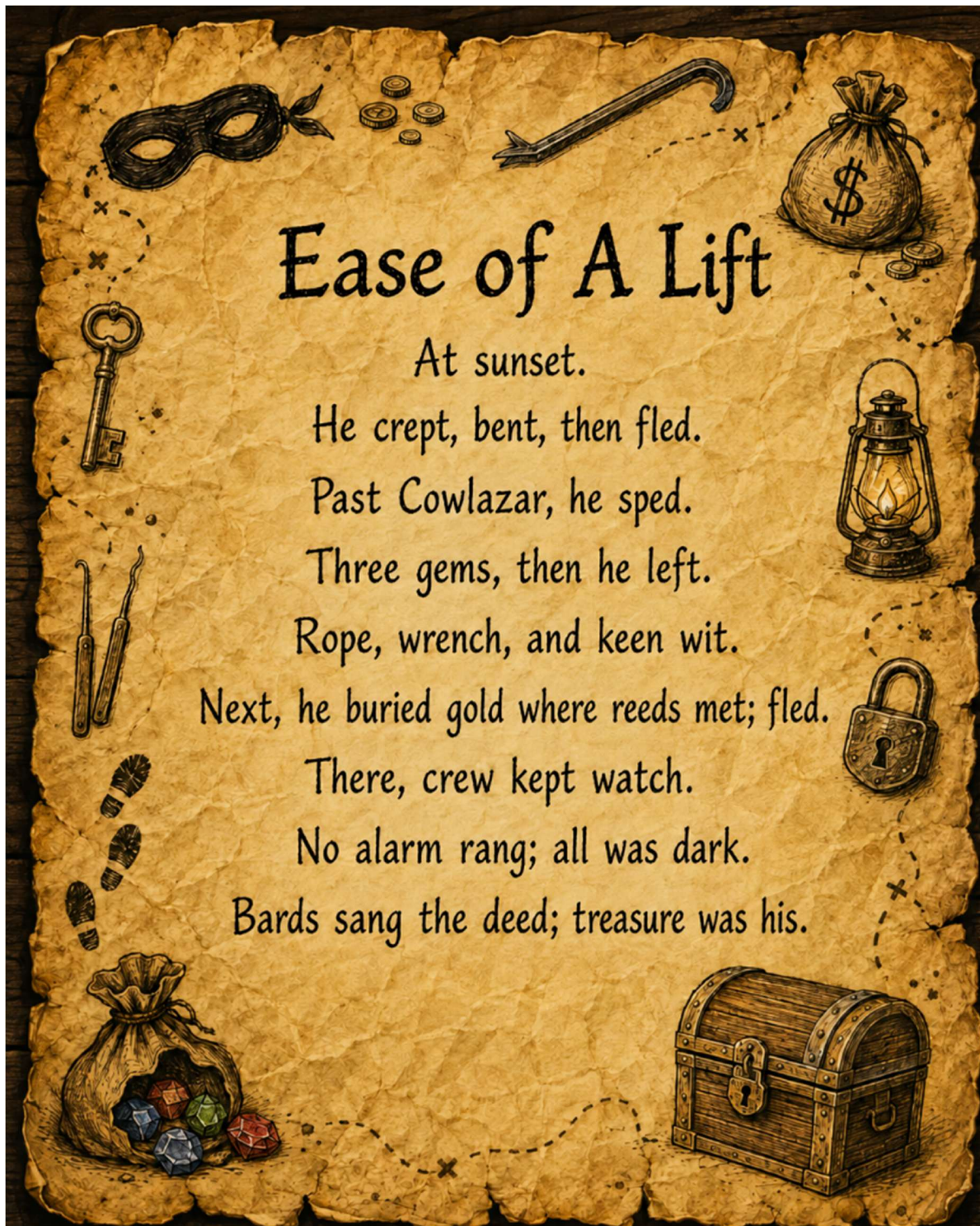
Witnesses report Good expressed an unusual enthusiasm for birds, frequently referring to them as "sky scouts" and indicating he uses bird activity to "time objective rotations." He was observed consulting a laminated bird checklist while sipping an energy drink.

Good was in the company of multiple wanted fugitives, including individuals with outstanding warrants for burglary, mischief, and ranked queue sabotage. He was also accompanied by an odd-looking animal described as a "small, purple, yordle-like creature" (later identified by animal control as a possum wearing a miniature hat and holding a tiny spear).

During consensual conversation, Good denied wrongdoing but stated, "We're just chasing lore, officer. The real treasure is LP." He claimed the group was only "proxying" hunts to avoid "counter-jungle by other teams," and denied having any knowledge regarding the storage locker robbery at The Treasure

Hunt Amusement Park. A search of his person revealed a scrap of parchment* with a poem written upon it.
